

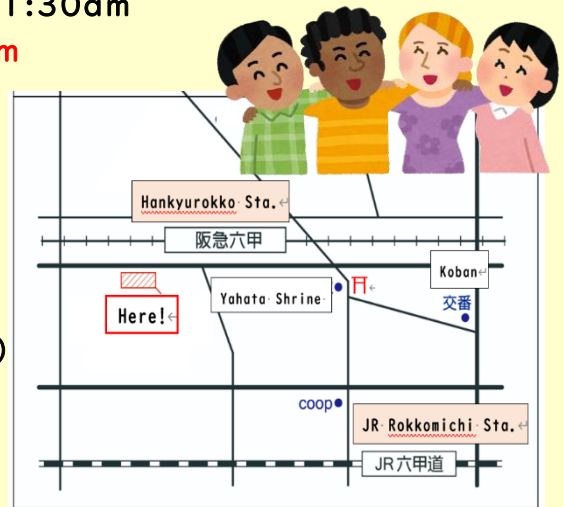
`Kanji for Everyday Life` Class for Local Residents Let's have fun studying Kanji !
